GIVE TO Hephzibah

Hephzibah's mission is to help children thrive and families flourish through innovative community-based programs. We offer short- and long-term group homes for children traumatized by neglect and abuse, child welfare and family services, foster care and adoption programs and award-winning day care on a sliding scale for families of all income levels.

Hephzibah Home: Hephzibah Children's Association operates two group homes for children between the ages of 3 and 12: our Diagnostic Treatment Center, where abused and neglected children undergo several months of stabilization and evaluation, and our Residence, a longer-term therapeutic program for severely traumatized children who need more time to heal.

Foster Care: The goal for every child who comes to Hephzibah Home is to start the healing process and prepare him or her for a return to family life with biological family members or in loving foster and adoptive homes. Hephzibah's foster parents are specially trained to provide the love, constancy and support needed to help neglected and abused children heal and learn to trust again.

Intact Family Services: Because every child deserves to live in a safe and nurturing environment, Hephzibah offers a wide range of support and intervention services for families in need. These include family support services, family assessment services, intact family services and family reunification services.

Day Care: Our Day Care activities are designed to help children achieve their full social, emotional and intellectual potential by fostering the development of a wide variety of skills, as well as social competence and a positive self-image. Children gain experience in areas such as arts and crafts, group games, movement and music, field trips and physical activities such as swimming and ice skating.

We are so grateful for the support of community members such as yourself to help lift that burden off our families. As you know, purchasing all the school supplies needed for the school year is a financial burden many families simply cannot afford. We are currently in need of school supplies for our back-to-school drive for our foster care and intact families, over 450 children!

Family Based Services

To meet the increasing demand in the community for foster care services and services for families in crisis, this past year Hephzibah announced that the Family Based Services division will double the number of foster children and intact families we serve. The Foster Care team serves more than 200 foster care children in specialty foster care who require extensive therapeutic and behavioral support. The Intact Family Services team provides intensive case management support for more than 300 low-income families in crisis due to poverty, substance abuse, domestic violence, homelessness, and other factors. The Family Based Services team also operates new Positive Parenting Program focuses on strengthening at-risk families and preventing abuse and neglect; and an adoption program for children who cannot return to their biological families.
